Itinerary

Day 1 NJP / Bagdogra to Darjeeling (4 Hrs Approx):-

As you begin with your majestic journey, you will first arrive at Bagdogra Airport or NJP Railway Station. To Guide your excitement our representative will be waiting for your warm welcome at the airport or NJP who will further arrange your transfer to enchanting Darjeeling, which is 2042 m above the Sea Level. Enroute have a glimpse of Kurseong valley. Check-in to your hotel and stay at your leisure.

Evening time enjoy the Mall, The Chowrasta or the Mall is the heart of Darjeeling town. Located on top of Nehru Road, this is a nice flat land where tourists and locals come to lounge in the sun, take a seat on one of the many benches along the periphery, and watch the wonderful views of the mountain peaks and valleys all around. Mall is like the town center or the social center of Darjeeling. This is where some of the old and heritage stores are lined up, like ,Nathmulls Tea Store & Sunset Lounge, Oxford Book Store, Golden Tips, Bhutia Market, Some Boutique & Handicraft Stores etc.

Overnight stay at Darjeeling.

Day 2 Darjeeling Local Sightseeing:-

Early morning visit TIGER HILL for the breathtaking view of "Sun rise" at KANCHENJUNGA, a lifetime experience to see "Golden Kanchenjunga" turning into "Red" and slowly into "Snow white" .Back to your hotel and have your delicious breakfast. We will now start for all local sightseeing places, like -

Batasia Loop- If you are taking a toy train ride from Darjeeling, you will pass by this magnificent loop. Otherwise, take a cab from Darjeeling town and visit the Batasia Loop. There is no better place to get a 360 degree view of Darjeeling's landscape including the hill town and the snow covered peaks of the Eastern Himalayas with the majestic Kanchenjunga on one side. And all this from the middle of a lovely flowering garden around which the toy train track is laid.

Tea Plantation - Tea plantations are little more than just a piece of terrace farming.

They are emerging as a new element of tourism, which is now called as tea tourism. Darjeeling is called as the Mecca of Tea. Darjeeling has more than 80 plantations scaling thousands of acres of lands along the slopes. You can find high grade first flush tea to exotic flavored teas here.

Ghoom Monastery - Old Ghoom Monastery is the popular name of Yiga Choeling. The monastery belongs to the Gelukpa or the Yellow Hat sect and is known for its 15 feet- high statue of the Maitreya Buddha

Rock Garden - The Rock Garden at Chunnu Summer Falls and Ganga Maya Park are recently added tourist attractions in the hilly town of Darjeeling in the state of West Bengal, India. It is a showpiece meant to lure people to Darjeeling after political agitations disrupted tourism in the 1980s.

Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park - Padmaja Naidu Himalayan Zoological Park is a 67.56-acre zoo in the town of Darjeeling in the Indian state of West Bengal. The zoo was opened in 1958, and an average elevation of 7,000 feet, is the largest high altitude zoo in India.

Back to hotel & Overnight stay at Darjeeling.

Day 3 Darjeeling to Pelling (4 Hrs Approx)

Today after morning breakfast transfer to enchanting Pelling, which is 1800 m above the Sea Level. Check-in to your hotel and stay at your leisure.

Pelling:- Pelling is a small town in the northeastern Indian state of Sikkim, at the foothills of Mount Khangchendzonga. The late-17th-century Buddhist Sanga Choling Monastery has mountain views. Pemayangtse Monastery features wall paintings, sculptures and a gold-plated statue of Guru Padsambhava. Overlooking a valley, the 17th-century Rabdentse Palace, now in ruins, still has evidence of the king's bedroom and kitchen. Overnight stay Pelling.

Day 4 Pelling Sightseeing:-

Today after breakfast you will proceed for full day sightseeing like:-

Rimbi Waterfall : You will run over the spouting stream of white that is the Rambi Waterfall on your approach to Khechopalri and Yuksam. It is a grand common setup loaded with normal excellence. The waterfall is a huge one and is encased by lavish greenery.

Khecheopalri Lake : Khecheopalri Lake, originally known as Kha-Chot-Palri, is a lake located near Khecheopalri village, 147 kilometres west of Gangtok in the West Sikkim district of the Northeastern Indian state of Sikkim

Darap Village : Darap Cherry Village is one of the few places undiscovered where travelers looking for a taste of bucolic life can escape from the maddening crowds of touristic places. The word Darap is originated from the limbo word 'Tan-lop' which literally means a plain or even land. It is located just 8 km from Pelling on the way to Khecheopalri and Yuksam.

Kanchenzonga Waterfall : At a distance of 10 km from Yuksom and 24 km from Pelling, Kanchenjunga Waterfalls is a stunning waterfall situated in the beautiful hill town of Pelling, Sikkim. It is one of the largest waterfalls in Sikkim and among the prime Pelling Tourist Places.

Singsore Bridge : Singsore Bridge is located about 5 km away from Pelling. It's considered as the highest bridge in Sikkim and the second highest suspended bridge in Asia.

After the above point visit back to your Hotel at Pelling & Overnight stay.

Day 5 Departure to Bagdogra Airport / NJP Railway Station:-

After breakfast in your hotel, check-out from your hotel and transfer to Bagdogra Airport/NGP Station for onward journey with pleasant memories of North East and the warmth of our hospitality in your heart.
